We have compared the survey results with our last survey of 3 year ago. (The 2019 results are on our website) and we are aware there has been a slight decline in satisfaction in some areas. We are taking immediate action on bullying and ensuring our pupils are well behaved. Being completely open with you, from a leadership perspective, we have faced many challenges steering the school through the pandemic over the last 2 years or so. We have had decisions to make, often at pace and it has not always been easy. We had hoped that this academic year we would be on a steady course of recovery but unfortunately staff absence has hit us hard, and not surprisingly, this has affected all aspects of the work of the school. Nevertheless, we have endeavoured to maintain the pupils' care, safety and continuity in teaching and learning which is reflected in the survey feedback.

Other themes raised by a few parents include:

- a wish for more extra-curricular activities
- more school trips
- greater communication and engagement with parents

Please be reassured that we take this and all feedback seriously. We will be working on actions at all levels to address some of the issues raised and will keep you updated. You will already have been notified about our Open Classroom week and I hope this helps to enable you to celebrate your child's learning and progress in the engaging environment of their classroom. Mrs Thompson and Ms Buckley are going to increase their presence on the playground at the beginning and end of school on different days throughout the week. Please do take this opportunity to speak with us.


We have not been able to respond to comments on the survey where names were not given. If you wish to receive a response to your viewpoint or concern, please do get in touch via the school office.
